Will is up here again for a few days to help clean the grain which we expect to sell right away before the spring work begins. We have the new granary just about finished & will clean it in there.

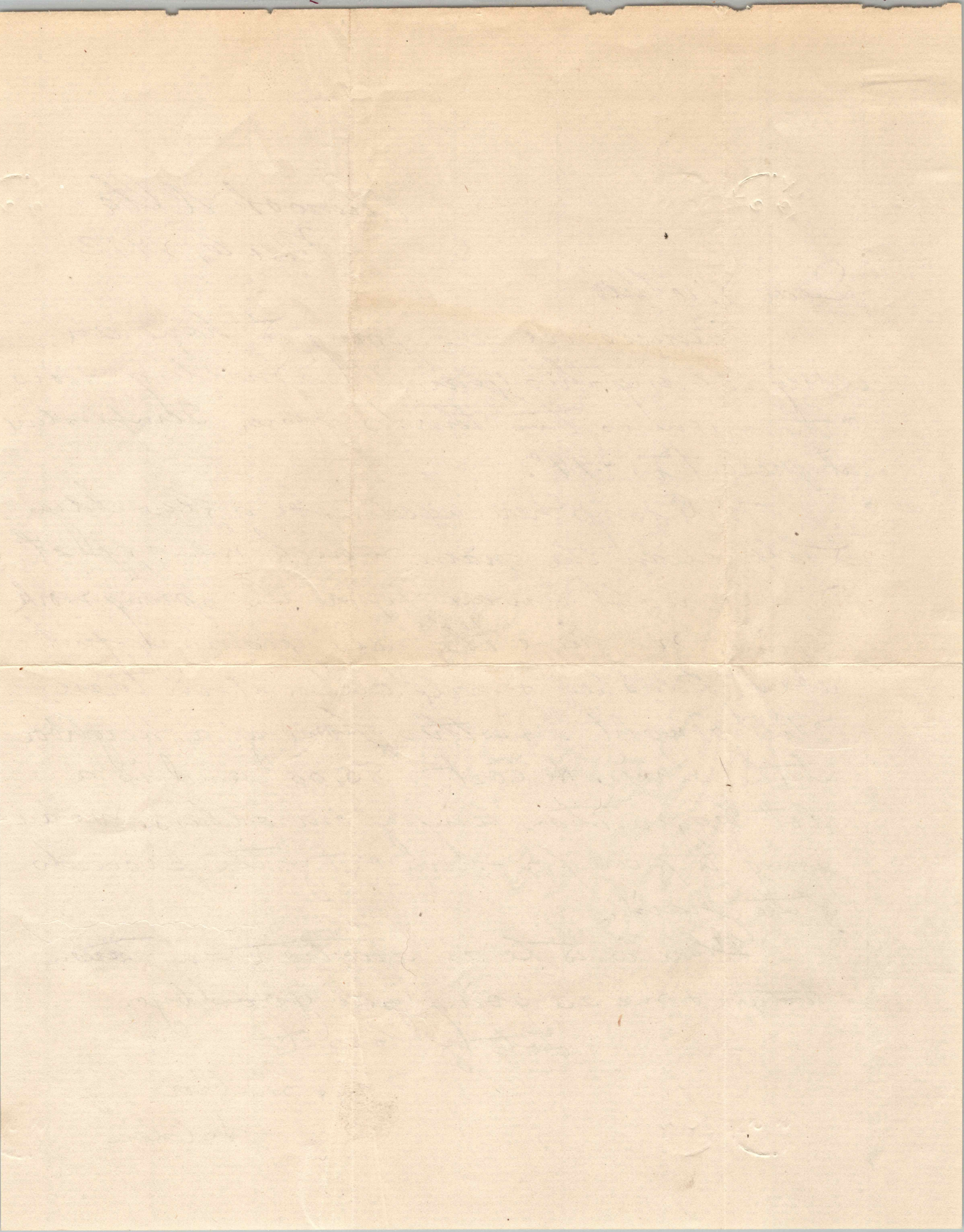
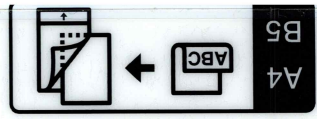
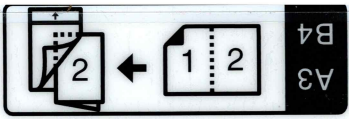
