Dear mother

Your letter came in this mail in which you said that you had sent my pen. I am using it now, but have no fountain pen ink so it does not work very well. I will have to get some somewhere. Thank you for getting & sending it.

I am very sorry that you somehow received the impression that we do not want to have you here, because we do. We are very anxious to have you. The only reason we could possibly have given you such an impression would be because we fear that the trip and visit here would be too hard on you. Do not for a minute doubt our sincerity when we say that we want you here.

I wish you could come for more than a month. You can hardly get used to the ways of things in so short a time. Please do not make anybody any promises to be back in Berlin at any particular time, because if you find things here sufficiently comfortable and you would like to, we want you to stay. I don't see why we should not have you with us part of the time just as much as Mary.

In regard to the dentist. There is one in Chinoak just at present & I am going to see him this afternoon. I will tell you next mail more about it. It will be absolutely impossible for me to go to Berlin to have my teeth attended to because we cannot afford it now. Please dismiss the matter from your mind for the present.

I am in a hurry to go to town now so goodbye. Lots of love
