Dear Mother

I am at Ogen today finishing up my application for patent for my homestead. I made out the application two or three weeks ago but did not have witnesses with me. Since then several neighbors have been in & witnessed for me & my papers have been gone three days. I would not have needed to come here if I had known that. It took only three hours to come over to, twenty miles. It will probably be about two months or more before I get my patent. It took well that long; two months.

The man with the gasoline engine has broken fifty acres on my place & is working now on Will's and has about ten done. It is very dry here now but there are light showers every day and it looks sure like rain every day. By a rain I mean a three or five day

rain, the kind that soaks in & does
some good. The crops are not hurt
yet but if there is not a good rain
within a few days they will be badly
damaged.

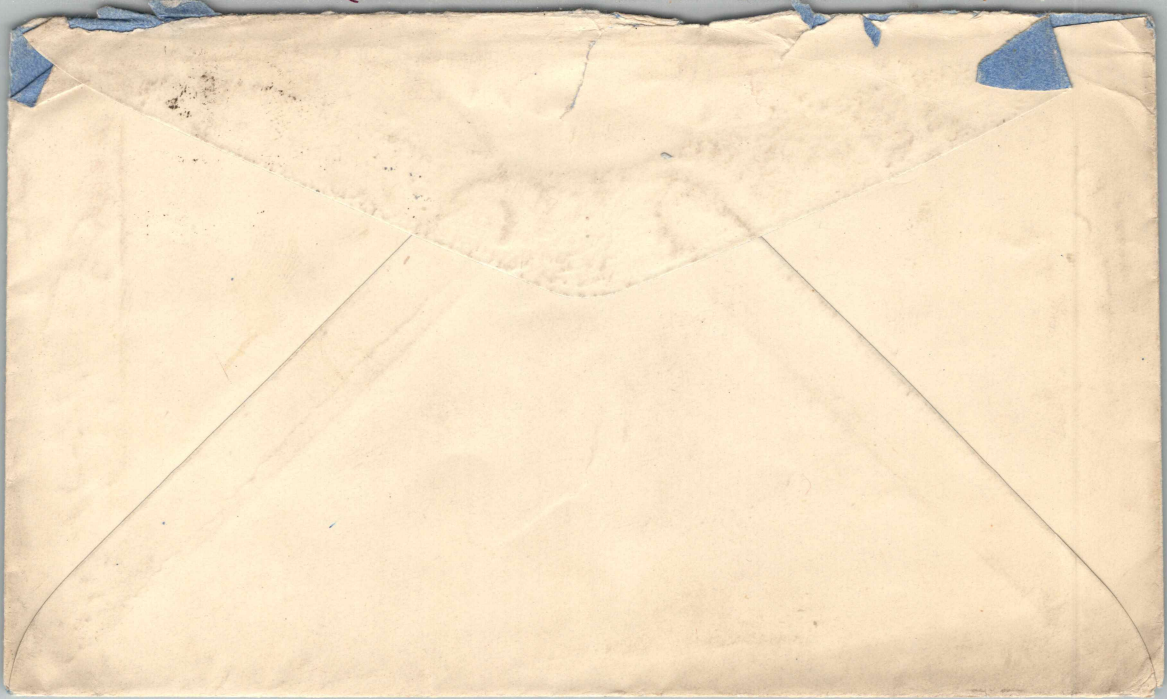
I very nearly had some of my teeth

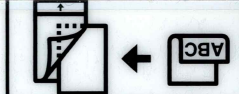
