WEST JERSEY PRESBYTERY.

**The Proceedings of a Two Days Session
at Greenwich.**

The Presbytery of West Jersey closed its two day's session at Greenwich, Cumberland county, Wednesday night.

The session was opened on Tuesday with a sermon by Rev. A. P. Botsford, of Weno-nah. Rev. H. R. Rundall, of Glassboro, was chosen moderator for six months. The commissioners chosen to represent the pres-bytery in the general assembly at Minneap-olis were Rev. A. Brodhead, of Bridgeton, Rev. William Aikman, of Atlantic City and Elders John S. Jessup, of Woodbury and Reuben Bancroft of this city.

Three young men of the senior class of Princeton seminary were examined and arrangements made for their ordination and installation, viz: F. R. Symmes at Fairton, May 13th, Mr. Custer at Elmer, June 3d, and E. M. Fergusson at Absecon and Pleas-antville.

The organization of a church at Pleasant-ville was reported, and committees were ap-pointed to organize churches at Holly Beach and Richland, if the way be clear. Money was also raised to cancel the mortgage on the church at Berlin.

During the session committees were ap-pointed to visit and hold evangelistic ser-vices as follows: To visit Swedesboro and Billingsport, and the German churches of Woodbury and Atlantic City, Messrs. Wer-ner, Baker, Schnatz, Louderbough and Bel-den; Absecon, Pleasantville and Leeds' Point churches, Messrs. Aikman, Headley and Mewhinny; May's Landing church, Messrs. Brodhead and Brace; Brainerd church, Messrs. Botsford and Harri-; Ham-monton church, Rev. V. D. Reed and Mr. Janeway; Atco, Berlin and Waterford churches, Messrs. Boyd, Woods and Up-ham; Glassboro and Bunker Hill, Mes-srs. Brownson and Randolph; Elmer church, Messrs. Tomson and Snyder; Green Creek and Holly Beach, Messrs. Park and Beadle. The chairman of committees are expected to write to moderators of churches to make more definite arrangements.

Home evangelization occupied much at-tention during the meeting. After a very pleasant session and with thanks for kind hospitality the Presbytery adjourned.
