Missionary from India, laboring

India next autumn. I have
spent 11 years in India; my work
has been both educational and
evangelical. I went to India in
1882, returned to this country last
year, and have been spending
the winter in the West. My wife
is with me, and we are now en-
tering East. About the middle
of June we expect to be in
Pittsburgh. Please let me know
