At the late annual meeting of
our Presby - Rio de Janeiro - 33
churches were reported with
2096 members in full commu-
nion - 300 had been added on
profession of faith during the
year. The contributions reported
for all purposes amounted to over
\$7000.

Two of our native
ministers, having 5 churches un-
der their care are supported inde-
pendently of the mission - another
^{with 1 ch.} receives from the mission only an
allowance for house rent. Still
^{with 4 churches} another, receives only ^{part} of his
support from mission funds. A de-
sire to become self supporting is
happily growing amongst our churches
& people.
