I have been doing medical work in Foochow for the last eight years.

Heart and brain grew so weary I had to come to America for rest and change. Have improved a good deal since I gave up my work and hope avail the restful influences of the homeland to accumulate much strength for future service in China.

I stopped in Chicago and saw my dear old teacher Miss E. Fryer. She wanted me to remember her to Dr. and Mrs. Foster.
