things etc,



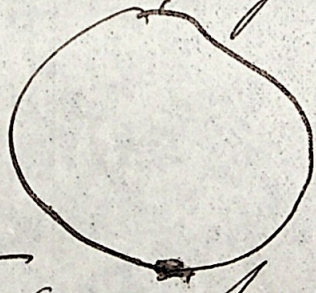
