Saw Experts to know about proper price for ads: in 2000 up to 40000 copies, issued single number or quarterly and simply found it impossible to make it pay its own expenses. The issuing Quarterly does not bring it within pound postage and to be entered as 2<sup>d</sup> Class Matter, it must have a bona fide subscription list, and

circulation when I had not  
a subscriber was too much  
for me, and to enter it as  
2<sup>d</sup> class matter, and start  
out to find a paper and  
work up subscription list  
and all that was more  
than I was willing to  
undertake personally, or  
in any way link the Union  
with it - so Gazette  
after the old personal  
style fell through.

But some business gentlemen  
here, have determined to  
establish a Missy Magazine  
after the style of my old Gazette  
and publish it Quarterly  
16 pp and Cover, for 25¢  
a year, probably 10 copies  
to one address for the year  
for 1.00 on condition that  
I will edit it; and I  
have consented to edit it  
on condition that I  
may put in all the  
I. M. U. material I  
please, and run it  
absolutely as I choose,  
to all which they agree -



I mean to put up the first number  
right away, giving at least half  
of the 16 pages to J. M. U. for  
last two meetings and the  
coming one - and will put it  
in anything you and Park please  
to send, and will send it  
to Rev. Missionary and to  
Binghamton for circulation  
freely - all without cost to  
J. M. U. - if publishers would  
agree to be responsible for  
our using 1000 copies, free  
I will do it on my own hook,  
but I am quite confident they  
will agree to anything I propose.  
Send me copy post haste, if any kind  
you please. Yours Gracey
