Auntly —

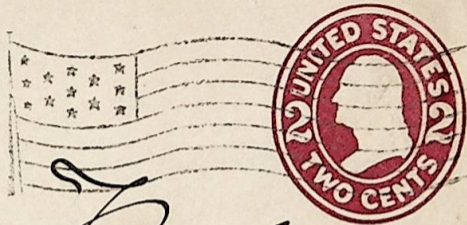

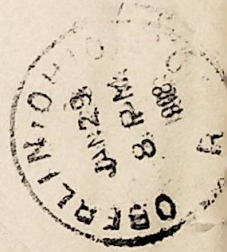
