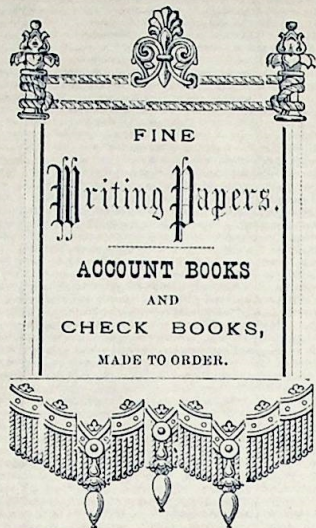
I have put the paper to you @ \$2⁰⁰! for name I can only say that it is lower than I have ever to my recollection sold that paper (or that grade!)
