Yours of the
10th inst reached me on the 12th. Sat
lath & Monday have intervened, &
I answer as promptly as I well
could. I am very glad in-
deed to see what is proposed,
and will try to do my part in
carrying it out. I think the
general plan outlined, is
wise and practicable both as
to time & method. The week
proposed seems to be the most
suitable, all things considered,
that could be chosen. The
work within the Presbyteries
can be arranged best by each
in its own bounds. The

Res of Elizabetta has a standing
Com on for Miss. At the
instigation of this Com & by the
direction of Pres, a series of
meetings of the nation now
proposed has been held (not
simultaneous indeed but on
appointed days) through our
churches, since our October meet-
ing. Five or six at least were
held between the 15th of Nov
& the middle of Jan or there-
about. The effect was good we
hope but the work was not
thorough or with enthusiasm
that a State movement will
call for. I think the Pres
therefore will enter cordially into
the movement proposed by
your Com. In our case I
think it will be best to put
management of it into the hands

of our Com on for Miss or of
a special Com raised for the pur-
pose. In our late series we simply
added two or three brethren to the
standing Com. Dr. Kelham is
now the Chairman of the Com
on for Miss; but all our stand-
ing Com^s will be reorganized at
our Apr meeting, when probably
changes will be made in all
of them. Still the Com on for
Miss will be the one to act in
this case and we will try to see
that the right men are put on
it. I think Dr. Geal, from posi-
tion & from personal fitness, is
the best man we have to be chair-
man of the Com and will try to
secure his appointment. Dr. Gil-
lespie is by his side as one of his congrega-
tion. — I will preserve the
