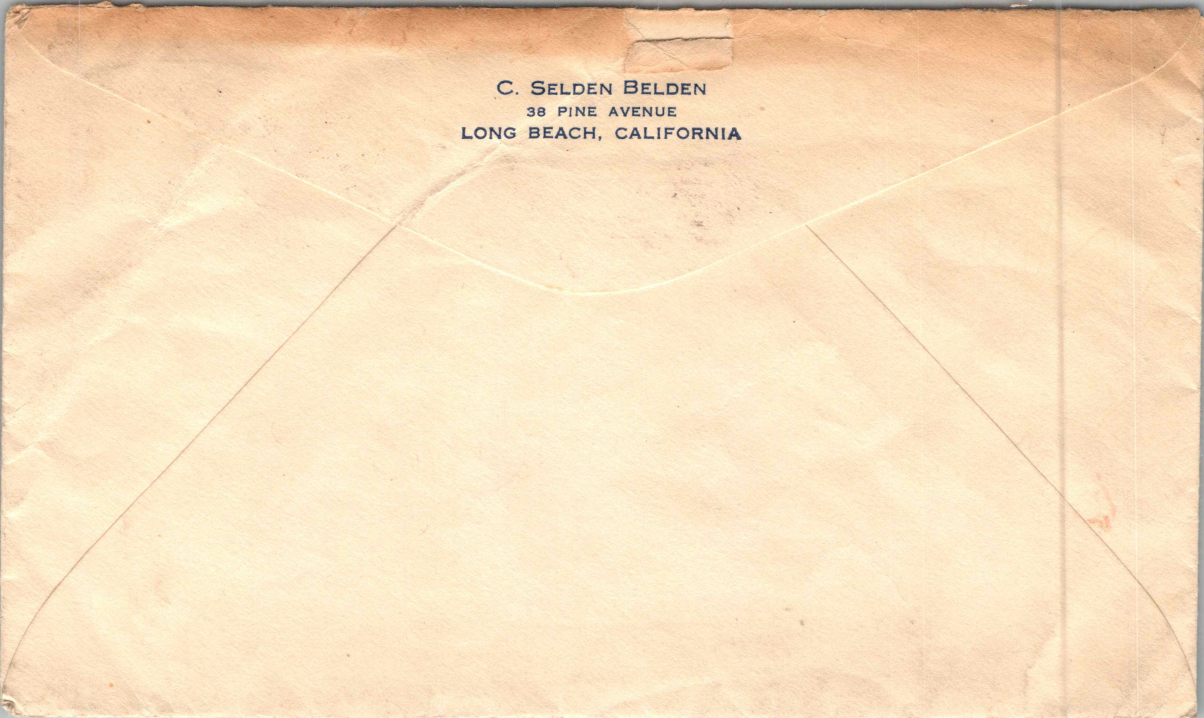
I hope you get a chance to visit with & get acquainted with Will again before he goes back to Alberta.

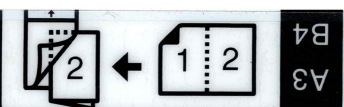

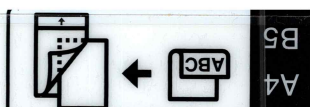
