of the church standing to indicate their
constant witness to Christ thereby.]

Confession.
We believe that there is but one
God, Who has revealed Himself as
the Father, Son & Holy Spirit.

We believe that the Scriptures of
the Old & New Testaments were given
by inspiration of God, & are the suf-
ficient & only infallible guide & rule
of life.

We believe that Jesus the Messiah
was God manifest in the flesh, Who
fulfilled the Law in His life, & atoned
for sin by His Death, the only Name
whereby men can be saved.

We believe that there is but one
condition of salvation, which is:

ifest in godly sorrow for sin, & in
a godly life.

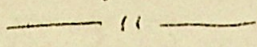
We believe that there is one Church

Covenant
Believing these things,
we have renounced & do renounce
the World, the Flesh, & the Devil;
& have taken God, the Father to be
our God, Jesus Christ to be our Savior,
& the Holy Spirit to be our Comforter &
Sanctifier, the word of God to
be our rule of faith & practice;
& the people of God to be our people;
and we give ourselves,
soul & body, time & talents, powers &

possessions,

intelligently, deliberately, sincerely,
unreservedly, freely, & forever,
to the service of the Lord.



Persons partaking of the Lord's Supper for the first time after having been received into the membership of the West church by the Session (whether coming by letter from other churches or from the world),

are expected to rise in their seats & come forward near the Minister, when they hear their names called; to remain standing (those to be baptized receiving baptism & afterward remaining standing) until after all the names have been called, the older members have risen to receive them, the hymn of welcome sung, & the Confession & Covenant read. In joining thus with the former members, they publicly profess their faith in Christ.
